INTERIM 2022 SCHEDULE

While legislators meet throughout the year to discuss many issues, official interim meetings happen once a month outside of the general legislative session. Each legislator is assigned two interim committees, which focus on specific topics. During the monthly meetings, each committee holds a public session where they address citizen concerns, new issues, potential bills for next year, and recently passed laws. They will also call in experts, organizations, businesses, and others to give reports on relevant topics.

Interim is held on the 3rd Wednesday of each month and begins in May (with a break in July).

Additionally, appropriations committees will meet three times during the interim to discuss budget-related items.


BEST OF STATE


